

Dear Ombudsman for banking,

I was on the telephone with Shawn Brignolio regarding the Lee's and my uncle's mortgage on their home. Shawn Brignolio didn't care for the Lee and didn't want to concern himself that what they are going through is a terrible injustice. My uncle defrauded them and is using the bank to hurt them.

They got a call from Shawn Brignolio in August 2006 telling them that it was not their mortgage. I know they wouldn't take this lightly and trusted and believed his call to them was evidence that they didn't owe the mortgage. They have since found out that while they were trying to get their lives together, the bank's law firm KRMC had slipped in a judgment on their home. I would have appeared in court for them if the court date was sent to them. I am telling you now that my uncle had defrauded them and is telling lies to hurt the Lees.

Is this what happens to people who have been victimized? I am having Larry send this email because I am at work now and cannot use time for personal use. I already took this today morning off to try to talk some sense into Shaw Brignolio but he is only interested in taking their home away. I am extremely disappointed that the bank will conspire with my uncle to hurt the Lees.

Please note below is a letter to anyone who will believe that the Lee's are and have been defrauded by my own uncle Verdun Bigelow. I hope this never gets to the papers because I will be there with others to support the Lees. I was present when my uncle was talking to Larry and Angela and I know what happened. My uncle took things, twisted them to his benefit and they ended up with a mess my uncle created for them.

OBSI you have to step in and stop this action that CIBC is doing to the Lee's. My uncle also destroyed their credit by putting in a false addition into their equifax. Call me if you want to talk and help the Lee's out of this mess. I work during the days and cannot accept personal calls. I do have an answering machine at home. Thank you...I feel terrible as it is...

To whom it may concern,

In 2003, my uncle Verdun Bigelow had an in-depth discussion with me, Randy Bigelow about purchasing a Calcium Carbonate mine from acting owner agent, Angela Lee. Mrs. Lee was selling the mine for mine owner geologists Mr. Kretschmar who already had a prior agreement and arrangements with Mrs. Lee.

Verdun Bigelow and myself came from Cobalt, Ontario. The distance to travel to this property is taxing because the property is located in Vansickle, Peterborough, Ontario. Verdun Bigelow convinced myself, and the Lee's that he wanted to run the mine and make a profit and would make arrangements for me to be in that part of the woods to do the work. I was a willing participant because I believed my uncle. He discussed the running of the mine with us and the lawyer and another on the telephone. His payment for the mine was arranged with the lawyer hired by Mr. and Mrs. Lee. My uncle was excited about the purchase of the mine. He was happy because the lawyer had made it simple for him to own the mine and for Ms Lee to pay off Mr. Kretschmar.

My uncle also had hired Ms. Lee prior to this promising to pay her the salary she was used to from her previous contract which she produced, and he accepted. He was irregular in paying her which caused her to face some financial problems.

My uncle and I paid the Lee's a visit in Nov 2003 to purchase the mine, and help resolve the problems caused by his failure to keep up with her salary payments which he agreed to do. The agreement at the lawyers was that Mr Bigelow, my uncle purchase the mine and pay off the Lee's bill –the mortgage owing in return for the mine. Mr. Kretschmar was well aware of the transaction. Ms Lee had informed me that she and Mr. Lee met with Mr. Kretschmar in March 2004 to discuss the problem with my uncle's use of different names.

The Lee's had never seen my uncle prior to Nov 2003. My uncle had always called them on the phone and I know my uncle, he has no idea of leaving people alone—he would bother them till it drove them crazy. He sent the Lee's money down for the deposit for the Vansickle mine in Feb 2004. Mr Kretschmar had taken a deposit from my uncle's deposit to pay off taxes and put a hold on the property. Mrs. Lee took her portion of pay, while the rest went to Mr. Bigelow's partnership bills with Mr.Lee. My uncle had instructed Mr. Lee to pay full attention to the mine because the President of Federal White Cement had already committed to purchasing all the stones off the Vansickle property. During this time, the lawyer was sorting some mistakes out with my uncle and later on I understood this to be the fact that my uncle's use of different names created a dilemma and this caused a lot of problems.

The mix up with Verdun Bigelow's different names caused a problem with the lawyers and the Lee's. Now, Mrs. Lee's couldn't fulfill the arrangement with Mr. Kretschmar because somehow my uncle had their property all tied up. My uncle then realized the dilemma and wouldn't offer to undo the mistake. He knew this was his opportunity to take the Lee's home and have the mine too. **I have talked to him about his actions which were deliberate and fraudulent. My uncle didn't care.** I feel bad about the Lee's because in all my contact with them, they have always been honest but confused about what took place. They pleaded with me to ask my uncle to allow them to make the payments on their family home. They were desperate and angry. At the time all they wanted was to make sure that they would not be kicked out of their home-- my uncle on the other hand wanted to kick them out! They have no idea what was going on...and was also angry with me. I explained to the Lee's that I was not a part of my uncle's underhanded way of doing business. The mix up could have been clarified by my uncle but he became greedy thinking he could benefit from the sale of the Lee's home.

At the time of the purchase of the mine in Nov 2003, Verdun Bigelow was working for Erana Mine's Edward Blanchard of Lively, Ontario. He had relentlessly called the Lee's and wanted the mining property at all cost. His time off work along with the costly telephone bills in his use of Erana mine's telephone cost him his job. He blamed the Lee's for this.

I am supporting the Lee's against my uncle because I know my uncle's intentions were not good and that he could have avoided all these problems; he just chose not to because he wanted to benefit from his owning the Lee's home. My uncle is an opportunist and I will not stand for someone who deliberately destroys a family—he has done a lot of harm to the Lee's and their child. The money my uncle has put as down payment, along with Mrs. Lee's salary and a Christmas present to the Lee's child is now totally listed fraudulently in the Lee's credit bureau. My uncle somehow reported this as money the Lee's owe the Ministry Government Services and himself Verdun Bigelow. My uncle actually borrowed this money off another uncle and has created a false entry into Equifax's database reporting system.

The fraudulent entry into Equifax's database has created havoc for the Lee's. My uncle has also bad mouthed both of them and their character in the mining industry --he drove Mrs Lee into depression when he mentioned that she was having sexual relationship with other men.. They have lost credibility in this business where Mrs Lee was becoming well known and respected. To give you an idea, amongst other involvements. in 2003, the Lee's were involved with a U.S. Prime contractor to have 1.25 million tones of calcium carbonate sold to the government there. My uncle wanted in on this. (They have proof.) The Lee's also had stocks worth a fortune which I believe my uncle wanted to have control over. I also have realized that Mr. and Mrs. Lee were both ill at the time and my uncle took advantage of them. I write this letter to ask you to realize my uncle knew at all times that he was not acting in good faith. This letter is rushed pls excuse the mistakes....
